The office building Two Hannover Square is also known as the BB&T Building.*

In the Building

Enter the BB&T Building through the revolving doors off Salisbury Street. Turn to the right and go up the escalator. Before 6pm on weekdays, go to the set of elevators on the right and go to the 23rd floor. When you get off of the elevator go left to the hallway and then take another left down the hallway. We are in the office with the wooden door and glass sidelights at the end of the hall. If you arrive after 6pm, see the guard at the desk located at the top of the escalator. You can use the phone at the desk to call us. (856-8800)

Parking

There are four public parking decks available in the general area of Two Hannover Square. They are: the Wake County Parking Deck; the Cabarrus Street Parking Deck; the Sheraton Parking Deck; and the Two Hannover Square Parking Garage.

Lot Rates

The rates for the Sheraton Parking Deck are as follows:

-\$2 for every hour or part and \$10 max per day

The rates for the Cabarrus Lot are as follows:

-1st 15 min free

-\$1 for next half hour or part, \$1 for next half hour or part, \$1 for each additional hour

-\$9 max daily

The rates for the Hannover Square Parking Garage are as follows:

-\$1 for every half hour or part and \$10 daily max

The rates for the Wake County Parking Deck are as follows:

-\$1 for first half hour or part, \$1 for next half hour or part, \$1 for each additional hour

-\$8 daily max

Recommended Lot Use and Directions

The two lots that will be easiest to use and find are the Sheraton Parking Deck and the Cabarrus Lot (first/ground level only). After you turn onto Gale Street (per directions below) you will pass a left turn into a small parking area and then another left that goes into a loading dock. The left for the Sheraton Lot will be your 3rd

left and it will have a “parking” sign above it. The turn for the Cabarrus Lot will be your 4th left. Public customers in the Sheraton Lot are required to use any level other than the ground level. The Sheraton lot is a use-then-pay type facility. The Cabarrus lot is a prepay type facility that accepts cash and Visa. Public customers in the Cabarrus Lot can only use the first level. If you are planning to use the Sheraton or Cabarrus Lots, then follow directions that terminate with turning onto Gale Street. The BB&T Building is directly across Salisbury Street from the 2 parking lots. If the Sheraton and Cabarrus lots are full, you will need to park in the Hannover Square Parking Garage located below the building (or in the Wake County Parking Deck—see directions below). This lot can be reached by turning around on Gale Street and then taking a right back onto Davie Street. At the next intersection of Davie and Salisbury take a right onto Salisbury Street. Salisbury Street dead-ends because of construction. At the dead end, turn left into the underground parking garage. If the Sheraton and Cabarrus Lots are full and you would rather park in the Wake County Parking Deck on Salisbury Street then you will need to turn around on Gale Street and return to Davie Street and take a left. Then take your very first right onto McDowell Street. Proceed to the very next block and take a right onto Martin Street. Go one block on Martin to Salisbury and take a right. The entrance to the Wake County Parking Deck will be on your right. You will need to walk one block south on Salisbury Street to get to the BB&T Building.

Directions

FROM AREAS NORTH OF RALEIGH

On US 1 and US 401 (Capital Boulevard)

Travel south, cross over I-440 (the Beltline) and pass exits for Atlantic Avenue, Old Wake Forest Road, and Wade Avenue. As you pass the Peace Street exit you will be on the northern edge of downtown; the name of Capital Boulevard changes to Dawson Street. Proceed through the next seven (7) intersections and the 8th intersection will be Davie Street. Turn left at large red and white Firestone® sign onto Davie Street. After going through the intersection of Davie and McDowell Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

On N.C. 50 (Creedmoor Road)

Proceed south to intersection with U.S. 70 (which is named Glenwood Avenue); turn left to travel on Glenwood Avenue; cross under I-440 (the Beltline); pass Oberlin Road and St. Mary’s Street, and proceed through the Five Points intersection. Pass over Wade Avenue and immediately exit right and merge onto Wade Avenue. Travel under Glenwood Avenue; bear right to leave Wade Avenue, and merge with eastbound Capital Boulevard; pass Peace Street exit and you will be on the northern edge of downtown; the name of Capital Boulevard changes to Dawson Street. Proceed through the next seven (7) intersections and the 8th intersection will be Davie Street. Turn left at the large red and white Firestone® sign onto Davie Street. After going through the intersection of Davie and McDowell Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

FROM AREAS EAST OF RALEIGH

On US 64 (New Bern Avenue)

Travel west, cross over I-440 (the Beltline) and proceed into the downtown area. At Tarboro Street, the name of New Bern Avenue changes to Edenton Street. After you pass the State Capitol and go through 2 intersections (Salisbury Street and McDowell Street) and take a left onto Dawson Street. Go through 4 intersections and at the 5th turn left at the large red and white Firestone® sign onto Davie Street. After going through the intersection of Davie and McDowell Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

On I-40

Proceed west to the intersection with I-440 (the Beltline) and merge left to take I-440 West; pass exits for Rock Quarry Road and Hammond Road, and exit right onto Saunders Street and head toward the downtown area. Stay to the right as road will fork and the road name will change to McDowell Street. Cross South Street, Lenoir Street, Cabarrus Street and turn right onto Davie Street. After turning onto Davie Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

On U.S. 70 and N.C. 50

Proceed north to the intersection with U.S. 401, bear right and continue. Cross under I-440 (the Beltline) and proceed into the downtown area. The street you are traveling on is Saunders Street. Stay to the right as road will fork and the road name will change to McDowell Street. Cross South Street, Lenoir Street, Cabarrus Street, and take a right onto Davie Street. After turning onto Davie Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

FROM AREAS SOUTH OF RALEIGH

On U.S. 401

Proceed north to intersection with U.S. 70 and N.C. 50, bear left and continue. Cross under I-440 (the Beltline) and proceed into the downtown area. The street you are traveling on is Saunders Street. Stay to the right as road will fork and the road name will change to McDowell Street. Cross South Street, Lenoir Street, Cabarrus Street, and turn right onto Davie Street. After turning onto Davie Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

On U.S. 1

Proceed north to the intersection with I-440 (the Beltline) and turn right to enter I-440. Pass exits for Gorman

Street, Lake Wheeler Road, cross over South Saunders Street and exit right to get down to South Saunders Street. Turn right to enter South Saunders Street and proceed north. Stay to the right as road will fork and the road name will change to McDowell Street. Cross South Street, Lenoir Street, Cabarrus Street and turn right onto Davie Street. After turning onto Davie Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

From Areas WEST of RALEIGH

On U.S. 64

Proceed east to intersection with U.S. 1 South; go under U.S. 1 and bear left to merge with U.S. 1; proceed north to intersection with I-440 (the Beltline) and turn right to enter I-440; pass exits for Gorman Street, Lake Wheeler Road, cross over South Saunders Street and exit right to get down to South Saunders Street; turn right to enter South Saunders Street. Stay to the right as road will fork and the road name will change to McDowell Street. Proceed north and cross South Street, Lenoir Street, Cabarrus Street and turn right onto Davie Street. After turning onto Davie Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

On I-40 (Wade Avenue)

Proceed east and bear right at the fork where Wade Avenue (North Raleigh) goes to the right and I-440/40 goes left; proceed east on Wade Avenue when it enters Raleigh. Cross Dixie Trail, Brooks Avenue, Canterbury Road, Oberlin Road, St. Mary’s Street; pass under Glenwood Avenue; bear right to leave Wade Avenue and merge with Capital Boulevard. Pass Peace Street exit and you will be on the northern edge of downtown; the name of Capital Boulevard changes to Dawson Street. Proceed through the next seven (7) intersections and the 8th intersection will be Davie Street. Turn left at large red and white Firestone® sign onto Davie Street. After going through the intersection of Davie and McDowell Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.

On U.S. 70 (Glenwood Avenue)

Proceed east, cross under I-440 (the Beltline) and the street name of the road you are traveling on is Glenwood Avenue; pass Oberlin Road and St. Mary’s Street, and proceed through Five Points intersection. Pass over Wade Avenue and immediately exit right and enter Wade Avenue. Travel under Glenwood Avenue; bear right to leave Wade Avenue, and merge with Capital Boulevard; pass Peace Street exit and you will be on the northern edge of downtown; the name of Capital Boulevard changes to Dawson Street. Proceed through the next seven (7) intersections and the 8th intersection will be Davie Street. Turn left at large red and white Firestone® sign onto Davie Street. After going through the intersection of Davie and McDowell Street proceed ½ of one block to Gale Street and take right. There will be a sign above Gale Street that says “Public Parking.” Entrances to the two closest parking decks will be on your left. If you hit Salisbury Street you have gone too far.
